Flood Protection Safety Reminder from SaskEnergy and TransGas

As municipalities and landowners across Saskatchewan begin efforts to protect property from damage associated with anticipated high spring run-off and possible flooding, SaskEnergy and TransGas would like to ensure the safety of work crews, equipment operators, and their communities during these projects.

SaskEnergy and TransGas encourage everyone to contact Sask 1st Call, Saskatchewan's underground facility location service, before beginning any work involving ground disturbance. Sask 1st Call can be contacted toll-free at **1-866-828-4888**, within two working days SaskEnergy, and the other member companies of Sask 1st Call, will then locate the underground facilities at the project site, allowing work to continue without impacting buried infrastructure, or disrupting service to customers.

During flooding, the potential exists for ground cover to be washed away from pipelines. Please report any exposed pipelines immediately to Sask 1st Call. At any time, if workers or homeowners suspect there is a natural gas leak, contact SaskEnergy immediately at **1-888-7000-GAS (1-888-700-0427)** or TransGas Gas Control at **1-306-777-9800**.

SaskEnergy and TransGas have service, maintenance and construction personnel available 24/7 throughout the province to respond to any emergency situation which may occur this season. We are also working to co-ordinate our resources with local and provincial emergency response groups and organizations.
