The “Catch for KidSport” program was just the start of a solid 12-year relationship between SaskEnergy and KidSport.

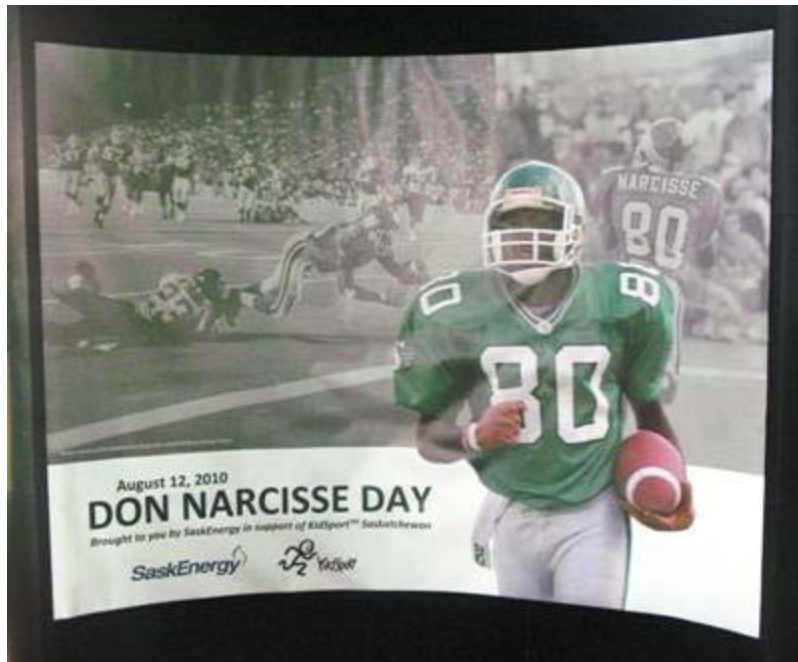
