

## Young curlers to get the chance to star at the Brier

On November 14, Trish Paulsen, reigning Canadian Junior Women's Curling Champion, and Jess Kraus, former Junior Star, joined 40 junior curlers at Saskatoon's Nutana Curling Club to help launch the 2012 SaskEnergy Junior Stars Contest. Through the Junior Stars initiative, young Saskatchewan curlers will have a chance to get the star treatment at the 2012 Tim Hortons Brier.



The contest will select 24 lucky junior curlers (12 female and 12 male) to serve as SaskEnergy Junior Stars at the Brier, scheduled for March 3-11, 2012 in Saskatoon. Each candidate has to be between the ages of 12 and 18, and affiliated with a junior curling team in Saskatchewan. The candidates have to submit a 100-word essay describing why they should be a Junior Star and outlining their community involvement. The SaskEnergy Junior Stars Contest is open to all active Saskatchewan Junior Curling Club participants and School Curling Team Members between the ages of 17 and 18. There is no cost to enter. One entry per person. Winners are responsible for their own accommodation, transportation, parking and meals.

Once selected, each Junior Star will be made an honorary member of one of the rinks competing in the Brier. They receive an official event jacket, have their photo taken with the team, and are introduced with their team at a pre-game ceremony. As well, each Junior Star receives tickets for themselves and two guests to attend a round-robin game, the chance to meet the TSN broadcast crew, and a special gift provided by SaskEnergy and the Tim Hortons Brier.

SaskEnergy debuted the popular Junior Stars Contest at the 2006 Tim Hortons Brier in Regina. We have since organized the initiative at two other Regina events – the 2008 Scotties Tournament of Hearts and the 2011 Ford World Men's Curling Championship.
