**IN ADDITION**, you may be eligible for a rebate if you have **purchased & installed** any of the following...

- **\$1,000 rebate** - Solar domestic hot water heating system certified to the CAN/CSA F379 standard and provides a minimum energy contribution of 6 GJ/year
- **\$150 rebate** - Drain-Water Heat Recovery (DWHR) system
- **\$3,500 rebate** - CAN/CSA-C448 compliant Geothermal system (ground or water source heat pump)  
\*Terms & Conditions Geothermal Note
- **\$100 rebate** - One qualifying natural gas appliance **OR** **\$250 rebate** - Two qualifying natural gas appliances

## Terms & Conditions

- To qualify for any/all of the rebates, you must purchase a **newly constructed ENERGY STAR qualified, R-2000 certified or EnerGuide for New Homes rating of 80 or above home**. One rebate only, per rebate option, per Saskatchewan address. Homebuilders are not eligible for the rebate(s).
- All homes must be tested and certified within 6 months of possession date. Rebate form must be filled out completely, signed and postmarked no later than 12 months after possession date.
- Prior to the payment of any rebate, or at any time, SaskEnergy reserves the right to conduct an on-site inspection to confirm the equipment has been installed and is in operation. A site visit is not a safety review, nor is it intended for any other purpose.
- All installations must be performed by a licensed contractor at the address listed on the rebate form. All installations must conform to all applicable codes. SaskEnergy does not endorse, guarantee or warrant any particular product, contractor, manufacturer or installation.
- SaskEnergy is not responsible for the loss or damage that may be caused as a result of the installation or operation of the equipment.
- Qualifying Natural Gas Appliances (receipt required):
  - clothes dryer
  - cooktop
  - barbecue
  - range
- Rebate(s) will be issued by cheque.

### GEOTHERMAL NOTE:

The Geothermal rebate option, funded by SaskPower, is effective for homeowners who took possession of their new home on or after January 1, 2008. In order to qualify for the rebate you must meet all of the following criteria:

- Geothermal systems must be CAN/CSA-C448 compliant and certified by the Canadian GeoExchange Coalition (CGC). Please submit a copy of the CGC Certificate with your application.
- There is no access to natural gas+. If a home does have access to natural gas, in order to be eligible for the Geothermal rebate option the homeowner must install an onsite renewable energy source++ large enough to offset the estimated increased electrical load and have a net metering system installed (or not be connected to the electrical grid).

+Definition of "no access to natural gas" – there is currently no natural gas service to the property and the cost of having SaskEnergy install a natural gas service line is equal to or greater than \$9,000 (excluding winter surcharges).

++Examples of renewable energy sources – solar or wind.
