

<p><b>1.0 Overview</b></p> <p><b>1.1</b> The Residential Equipment Replacement Rebate (the "Program") administered by SaskEnergy Incorporated ("SaskEnergy") is designed to stimulate investment in energy-efficient equipment ("Unit(s)") that may reduce natural gas and electrical usage and associated operating costs.</p> <p><b>1.2</b> The Program is targeted to the residential replacement market.</p> <p><b>1.3</b> The Program begins November 2, 2020 and ends March 31, 2021.</p> <p><b>1.4</b> The Program offers a rebate payment to partially offset the higher purchase price of higher efficiency Units.</p> <p><b>1.5</b> The Program is only available through a participating SaskEnergy Residential Network Member ("Network Member").</p> <p><b>2.0 Eligibility criteria</b></p> <p><b>2.1</b> A person or entity applying under the Program (the "Applicant") must be the registered homeowner and be a SaskEnergy residential customer.</p> <p><b>2.2</b> The residential property or dwelling where the Unit is installed must be located in Saskatchewan.</p> <p><b>2.3</b> Unit must be part of the primary space and/or water heating system.</p> <p><b>2.4</b> Units installed in new construction are not eligible for the rebate.</p> <p><b>2.5</b> Only residential properties are eligible. This includes row housing and duplexes that are metered separately/have a dedicated meter.</p> <p><b>2.6</b> Garage structures (urban/rural) are not eligible. Attached residential garages are not eligible.</p> <p><b>2.7</b> Existing furnaces and boilers being replaced must be over 10 years old; tankless water heaters, condensing water heaters, and tank water heaters being replaced must be over 6 years old. HRV eligibility is not conditional on age of existing equipment.</p> <p><b>2.8</b> Only eligible Units under the Program qualify for the Program rebate (see section 4.0).</p> <p><b>2.9</b> Unit must be purchased from, and installed by, a participating Network Member.</p> <p><b>2.10</b> Unit must be purchased and installed between November 2, 2020 and March 31, 2021.</p> <p><b>2.11</b> The Network Member is responsible for disposal or recycling of the old Unit.</p> <p><b>2.12</b> Applications must be received by SaskEnergy within 30 days of the completed installation or before April 30, 2021, whichever comes first.</p> <p><b>3.0 Program process</b></p> <p><b>3.1</b> Applicant's participating Network Member determines the capacity and Unit required to meet the space and/or water heating requirements of the property or dwelling.</p> <p><b>3.2</b> Units must be installed and properly commissioned by the Network Member.</p> <p><b>3.3</b> Participating Network Member completes both the Residential Equipment Replacement Rebate application form and the Installation and Satisfaction Acknowledgment. The Applicant reviews the information on these forms for accuracy and signs both. Participating Network Member sends the signed forms to SaskEnergy (at the address listed in Section 8.0) along with required documentation (See Section 7.0 for required documentation). These documents must be received by SaskEnergy within 30 days of the completed installation or before April 30, 2021, whichever comes first.</p> <p><b>3.4</b> SaskEnergy processes the application.</p> <p><b>3.4.1</b> If all documents are in order and the Applicant has met all the Program requirements, SaskEnergy sends a letter and an enclosed cheque (or applies a credit to the account, if applicable) to the Applicant within 6 weeks of receiving the application.</p> <p><b>3.4.2</b> If the documents are not in order, SaskEnergy may ask for additional documentation or information.</p> <p><b>3.4.3</b> If the application is invalid or can otherwise not be processed, SaskEnergy will advise the Applicant by letter.</p> <p><b>4.0 Eligible Units</b></p> <p><b>4.1</b> All space and/or water heating Units installed must use natural gas (with the exception of HRVs).</p> <p><b>4.2</b> The Unit must be new. Used or rebuilt Units are not eligible for a rebate.</p> <p><b>4.3</b> All Units must be installed in accordance with the manufacturer's specification and must comply with applicable laws, codes, standards and ordinances.</p> <p><b>4.4 Eligible furnaces</b></p> <p><b>4.4.1</b> Furnaces must be:          (a) a minimum 96%+ AFUE (annual fuel utilization efficiency), 2 stage gas with an ECM (electronically commutated motor) DC (direct current) motor; or          (b) a minimum 97%+ AFUE, modulating furnace with a variable speed (ECM) motor.          (c) specifically identified on the eligible furnace list maintained by SaskEnergy (i.e. manufacturer name and model number). A copy of the eligible furnace list is published on saskenergy.com. This list is subject to change without notice.</p> <p><b>4.5 Eligible boilers</b></p> <p><b>4.5.1</b> Boilers must be:          (a) a high efficiency natural gas condensing boiler and be a minimum 95%+ AFUE; and          (b) specifically identified on the eligible boiler list maintained by SaskEnergy (i.e. manufacturer name and model number). A copy of the eligible boiler list is published on saskenergy.com. This list is subject to change without notice.</p> <p><b>4.6 Eligible combi boilers</b></p> <p><b>4.6.1</b> Combi boilers must be:          (a) a high efficiency natural gas combi boiler and be a minimum 95%+ AFUE; and          (b) specifically identified on the eligible combi boiler list maintained by SaskEnergy (i.e. manufacturer name and model number). A copy of the eligible combi boiler list is published on saskenergy.com. This list is subject to change without notice.</p> <p><b>4.7 Eligible heat recovery ventilators (HRV)</b></p> <p><b>4.7.1</b> HRVs must be:          (a) an ENERGY STAR® certified HRV; and          (b) specifically identified on the eligible HRV list maintained by SaskEnergy (i.e. manufacturer name and model number). A copy of the eligible HRV list is published on saskenergy.com. This list is subject to change without notice.</p> <p><b>4.8 Eligible tankless water heaters</b></p> <p><b>4.8.1</b> Tankless water heaters must be:          (a) an ENERGY STAR® certified natural gas tankless water heater; and          (b) specifically identified on the eligible tankless water heater list maintained by SaskEnergy (i.e. manufacturer name and model number). A copy of the eligible tankless water heater list is published on saskenergy.com. This list is subject to change without notice.</p> <p><b>4.9 Eligible condensing water heaters</b></p> <p><b>4.9.1</b> Condensing water heaters must be:          (a) an ENERGY STAR® certified natural gas condensing water heater; and          (b) specifically identified on the eligible condensing water heater list maintained by SaskEnergy (i.e. manufacturer name and model number). A copy of the eligible condensing water heater list is published on saskenergy.com. This list is subject to change without notice.</p> <p><b>4.10 Eligible tank water heaters</b></p> <p><b>4.10.1</b> Tank water heaters must be:          (a) an ENERGY STAR® certified natural gas tank water heater; and          (b) specifically identified on the eligible tank water heater list maintained by SaskEnergy (i.e. manufacturer name and model number). A copy of the eligible tank water heater list is published on saskenergy.com. This list is subject to change without notice.</p>	<p><b>5.0 Rebates</b></p> <p><b>5.1 Furnace rebate</b> will be calculated as follows:  <b>5.1.1</b> \$325 for each 96%+ AFUE 2 stage eligible furnace.  <b>5.1.2</b> \$650 for each 97%+ AFUE modulating eligible furnace.</p> <p><b>5.2 Boiler rebate</b> will be calculated as follows:  <b>5.2.1</b> \$10 per MBH (1000 BTU/hr), up to a maximum of \$2,000 for a 95%+ AFUE eligible boiler.</p> <p><b>5.3 Combi boiler rebate</b> will be calculated as follows:  <b>5.3.1</b> \$5 per MBH (1000 BTU/hr), up to a maximum of \$1,000 for a 95%+ AFUE eligible combi boiler.</p> <p><b>5.4 HRV rebate</b> will be calculated as follows:  <b>5.4.1</b> \$100 for each eligible ENERGY STAR® certified HRV.</p> <p><b>5.5 Tankless water heater rebate</b> will be calculated as follows:  <b>5.5.1</b> \$1,000 for each eligible ENERGY STAR® certified tankless water heater.</p> <p><b>5.6 Condensing water heater rebate</b> will be calculated as follows:  <b>5.6.1</b> \$1,000 for each eligible ENERGY STAR® certified condensing water heater.</p> <p><b>5.7 Tank water heater rebate</b> will be calculated as follows:  <b>5.7.1</b> \$250 for each eligible ENERGY STAR® certified tank water heater.</p> <p><b>5.8</b> Rebates cannot be assigned or transferred by the Applicant.</p> <p><b>6.0 Additional terms &amp; conditions</b></p> <p><b>6.1</b> SaskEnergy reserves the right to amend, modify or terminate the Program at any time with or without notice, and is not obligated to make any payments whatsoever.</p> <p><b>6.2</b> SaskEnergy, in its sole discretion, reserves the right to limit the number of rebates, and/or the amount of a rebate, payable to an Applicant or in respect of a building.</p> <p><b>6.3</b> If SaskEnergy amends or modifies the Program after an application is received and approved by SaskEnergy, the Applicant cannot resubmit an application for the same Unit under the amended or modified Program.</p> <p><b>6.4</b> Applicant acknowledges their Unit may use less natural gas and electricity and produce fewer emissions. Applicant agrees to permit SaskEnergy to view the utility bill(s) for the building containing the eligible Unit to monitor and publicly report on changes in energy consumption as a result of the eligible Unit. All information regarding energy consumption used in promotional material will be aggregated with other buildings in the Program.</p> <p><b>6.5</b> SaskEnergy reserves the right to audit rebates paid through the Program including the right of a SaskEnergy representative to inspect, after installation, a premise that was the subject of an application to confirm the indicated Unit was installed.</p> <p><b>6.6</b> SaskEnergy or an authorized third party may contact Applicants to conduct survey(s) regarding the Program or to follow-up with the Applicant with respect to the Program and/or the Unit installed.</p> <p><b>6.7</b> Applicant agrees to transfer to SaskEnergy, ownership of credit for greenhouse gas reduction and/or carbon credit associated directly or indirectly with the Unit.</p> <p><b>6.8</b> Applicant grants SaskEnergy the right to use any funds provided under the Program, in full or in part, to set-off any amounts payable by the Applicant to SaskEnergy. SaskEnergy reserves the right to apply this set-off in its sole discretion.</p> <p><b>6.9</b> In addition to these terms and conditions, the Program, and any rebate payments made under the Program, are subject to terms and conditions contained in the application form and related documents. In the event of a conflict, the terms and conditions stated herein will prevail.</p> <p><b>6.10 Representation and warranties</b>          Applicant represents and warrants that it complies, and will continue to comply, with the Program eligibility criteria contained herein.</p> <p><b>6.11</b> Applicant represents and warrants that all information provided in relation to the Program is complete, true and correct. Applicant agrees it will notify SaskEnergy in the event there is a material change in its application or information attached thereto.</p> <p><b>6.12 Default</b>          In the event the Applicant fails to adhere to the terms and conditions contained herein, SaskEnergy reserves the right to void the application documents and SaskEnergy will be released from any and all obligations under the Program. In the event the Applicant fails to adhere to these terms and conditions, is or becomes ineligible for any reason to receive a rebate paid to it, or receives a rebate in error, SaskEnergy reserves the right to collect any rebate paid as a debt owed to SaskEnergy.</p> <p><b>6.13 Liability</b>          SaskEnergy will have no ownership interest in the Unit.</p> <p><b>6.14</b> SaskEnergy, not being the designer or manufacturer of the Unit, makes no representation or warranty, express or implied, as to the fitness, design or capability of the material, Unit or workmanship in the Unit, nor any warranty that the Unit will satisfy the requirements of any law, specification, or contract.</p> <p><b>6.15</b> Applicant will be solely responsible for and shall indemnify and save harmless SaskEnergy and its subsidiaries and its respective employees, directors, agents, contractors, sub-contractors and representatives from any liability, all claims, demands, causes of action, suits, judgments and penalties whatsoever and wheresoever arising out of or in relation to the Program including, without limitation, those made or sustained in respect of property damage, personal injury (including death), infringement of copyright or trademark, builders or other liens.</p> <p><b>6.16</b> SaskEnergy does not endorse or warrant any particular manufacturer, product, system, design, supplier, or installer in relation to the Program.</p> <p><b>6.17</b> SaskEnergy does not guarantee that the Applicant will benefit from reduced utility costs as a result of the Unit.</p> <p><b>6.18 Tax implication</b>          SaskEnergy will not be responsible for any tax liability imposed on the Applicant as a result of payment of the rebate.
